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Off-Season Storage

There are a number of issues that affect storage of power equipment. Gasoline breaks down, leaving a varnish-like coating inside fuel tanks, lines, carburetor circuits and makes rubber and plastic parts brittle. Also, tires flatten and dry-rot. Unprotected metal surfaces rust. To avoid damage and expensive repairs you may perform a Pre-Storage Service.

Depending on type of equipment you may wish to:

- Change your oil and oil filter (in models w/ internal oiling and oil filter).
- Inspect fuel filter and replace if necessary.
- Inspect spark plugs and replace if fouled.
- Sharpen blades/chains or replace if damaged. (mowers and chainsaws).
- Drain fuel from fuel tank and run engine until it runs out of fuel. (Alternatively you can dose fuel with a fuel stabilizer).
- Blow off dirt and debris.
- Grease all bearings and mechanisms requiring grease.
- Inspect wear items such as belts, starter cords, tires, and cables and replace if damaged or badly worn.
- Lift equipment and set on blocks to avoid flattening and cracking tires.
- Cover equipment to protect from sun and weather.

Check these items off your “Honey-Do” list and you should have fewer frustrations next Season when the equipment is needed again!
